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Fox River Locks 2019 Lockage Fees and Operations Schedule

Nine (9) Locks will be open and operated this season

- Menasha Lock
 - o Closed Until Further Notice
 - o 2015 Closure due to Aquatic Invasive Species (Round Goby)
- Appleton Locks 1,2,3 and 4
 - o May 17, 2019 – September 15, 2019
 - o Friday, Saturday and Sunday (including holidays) 11am - 9pm
 - o Locks are Operated on the Hour
- Cedars Lock
 - o May 25, 2019 - September 3, 2019
 - o Saturday and Sunday (including holidays) 11am - 9pm
 - o Memorial Day - Labor Day Weekend
- Little Chute Lock 2
 - o May 25, 2019 - September 3, 2019
 - o Saturday and Sunday (including holidays) 11am - 9pm
 - o Memorial Day - Labor Day Weekend
- Combined Locks
 - o May 25, 2019 – September 3, 2019
 - o Saturday and Sunday (including holidays) 11am - 9pm
 - o Memorial Day - Labor Day Weekend
- Kaukauna Locks 1,2,3,4 and 5
 - o Closed Until Further Notice
 - o City of Kaukauna - Memorial Bridge Repair Pending, Spring 2021
- Rapide Croche Lock
 - o Closed Until Further Notice
 - o 1985 Closure due to Aquatic Invasive Species
- Little Kaukauna Lock (Little Rapids)
 - o May 17, 2019 – September 15, 2019
 - o Seven Days a Week 10am - 10pm
 - o Fourth of July Open Until Midnight

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- De Pere Lock
 - o May 17, 2019 – September 15, 2019
 - o Monday – Thursday 10am - 10pm
 - o Friday, Saturday and Sunday 10am - Midnight
 - o Fourth of July Open Until Midnight
- Season Pass - \$100
 - o A permanently affixed season pass is valid all season, at open locks on the Fox River for motorboats and non-motorized boats.
 - o All passes are non-transferable.
 - o Season passes are required to be permanently attached in an area that will be most visible to a lock tender.

 - “Motorboat” means any boat equipped with propulsion machinery, whether or not the machinery is the principal source of propulsion, a boat propelled usually by an internal combustion engine. The term includes but is not limited to powerboat, speedboat, fishing boat or cabin cruiser.

 - “Non-Motorized Boat” means a boat which is not propelled by machinery but is designed and constructed to be used for transportation of a person or persons on water. This term includes but is not limited to canoe, sailboat, kayak, inflatable boat, row boat or dingy.
- Day Pass \$10 Recreational
 - o A daily pass is valid for one day, at open locks on the Fox River for motorboats and non-motorized boats.
- Commercial Vessels \$80 Per Lockage
 - o [http://docs.legis.wisconsin.gov/document/statutes/30.50\(3d\)](http://docs.legis.wisconsin.gov/document/statutes/30.50(3d))
 - “Commercial Motorboat” means a motorboat while it is being operated to transport property or passengers for hire or while it is being used by its operator or owner to earn a livelihood, to gain a profit or both. This term includes construction barges.
- Boat \$80 Per Trip Down and Back
 - “Tour Boat” means a motorboat transporting passengers to gain profit.
 - \$80 round trip down and back
 - Trip 1 De Pere and Little Kaukauna (Little Rapids)
 - Trip 2 Combined Locks, Little Chute Lock and Cedars Lock
 - Trip 3 Appleton Locks 1,2,3 and 4

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- Scheduled Paddle Events \$1.00 Each, Minimum 25 Participants Per Lockage.
 - “Scheduled Paddle Events” are publicly advertised at least one month prior to the event in local newspapers and / or other media outlets.
- Special Lockage’s, After Hours and Off Season Require 24 Hours’ Notice for Staffing Purposes.
 - o \$50 Per Lockage for Motorized and Non-Motorized Boats.
 - o \$150 Per Lockage for Commercial Vessels, Except Tour Boats.
 - o \$150 Round Trip Little Chute and Appleton Locks for all Tour Boats.
 - o Less Than 24 Hours’ Notice of Cancellation Will Result in a Charge of \$40.
