## AGREEMENT TO RESOLVE CASE

The parties, through counsel, hereby agree to the following plea and sentence agreement for a resolution of the case:

## I. PLEA AGREEMENT

In exchange for the People's dismissal of Counts I and II of the Felony Information, defendant agrees to plead guilty to an added count of Attempted Accosting for Immoral Purposes MCL 750.145a. Attempted Accosting for Immoral Purposes is a misdemeanor with a statutory maximum penalty of two years.

## II. SENTENCING AGREEMENT

The People will agree to a county jail sentence not to exceed the calculated Michigan Sentencing Guidelines which are 0-6 months. If the Court will not follow the above sentence range as determined by the Michigan Sentencing Guidelines, the Court will allow the defendant to withdraw his plea and proceed to a jury trial with the plea record being suppressed. There will not be a conviction entered on defendant's plea. This is intended to be a binding plea and sentencing agreement.
