This letter is to notify you that your child has been exposed to someone with a confirmed case of COVID-19.

**Your child's last exposure was identified as:** October 6 (this is day zero when determining quarantine) Being exposed (or a "close contact") means that your child is at risk of developing COVID-19 anytime in the 14 days after exposure.

During this time, we ask that your child **quarantine**, which means:

- Your child should STAY HOME and separate from others and pets within your home
- Do not go to school or extra-curricular activities
- Monitor your child daily for any symptoms of COVID-19:
  - Cough
  - Shortness of breath
  - Abdominal pain
  - Fever/chills/sweats
  - Loss of taste / smell
  - Nausea/vomiting/diarrhea
  - Sore throat
  - Muscle Aches
  - Headache
- Your child should be tested for COVID-19 if any symptoms develop.
- Please reach out to your healthcare provider for any health advice and care. If your child has a medical emergency, call 911. Notify any medical facility of your child's COVID-19 exposure prior to seeking care.

Quarantining (staying home) for a full 14 days after an exposure remains the safest strategy for preventing asymptomatic transmission of COVID-19. However, your school allows two shorter quarantine options outlined by WI Department of Health Services to help ease the burden of quarantine if no symptoms have been reported during daily monitoring:

- After 10 days without testing **Day 11 which is 10/17/21** OR
- After 7 days with proof of negative **PCR COVID-19 test**

(collected day 6 or 7 which is 10/12 or 10/13) **Day 8 which is 10/14/21**

While on quarantine, your child is expected to continue with your classes by following the daily assignments on Google Classroom. There is also a link to attend class via google meet posted in each Google Classroom. Quarantined students can attend via meet, however, it is not a requirement. It is there so students can hear/see the things that may help with the required assignments. The teachers will have a chrome book logged into the meet so that quarantined students can see the instruction happening in the classroom. If you are attempting to log into a class and the teacher isn't there, please call the office at 337-1020.

**The amount of time your child needs to stay at home will change if he/she tests positive, develops symptoms, or is re-exposed during their quarantine.** If they are fully vaccinated, they may not need to quarantine but should still be tested 3-5 days after exposure and monitor them for symptoms for 14 days.
