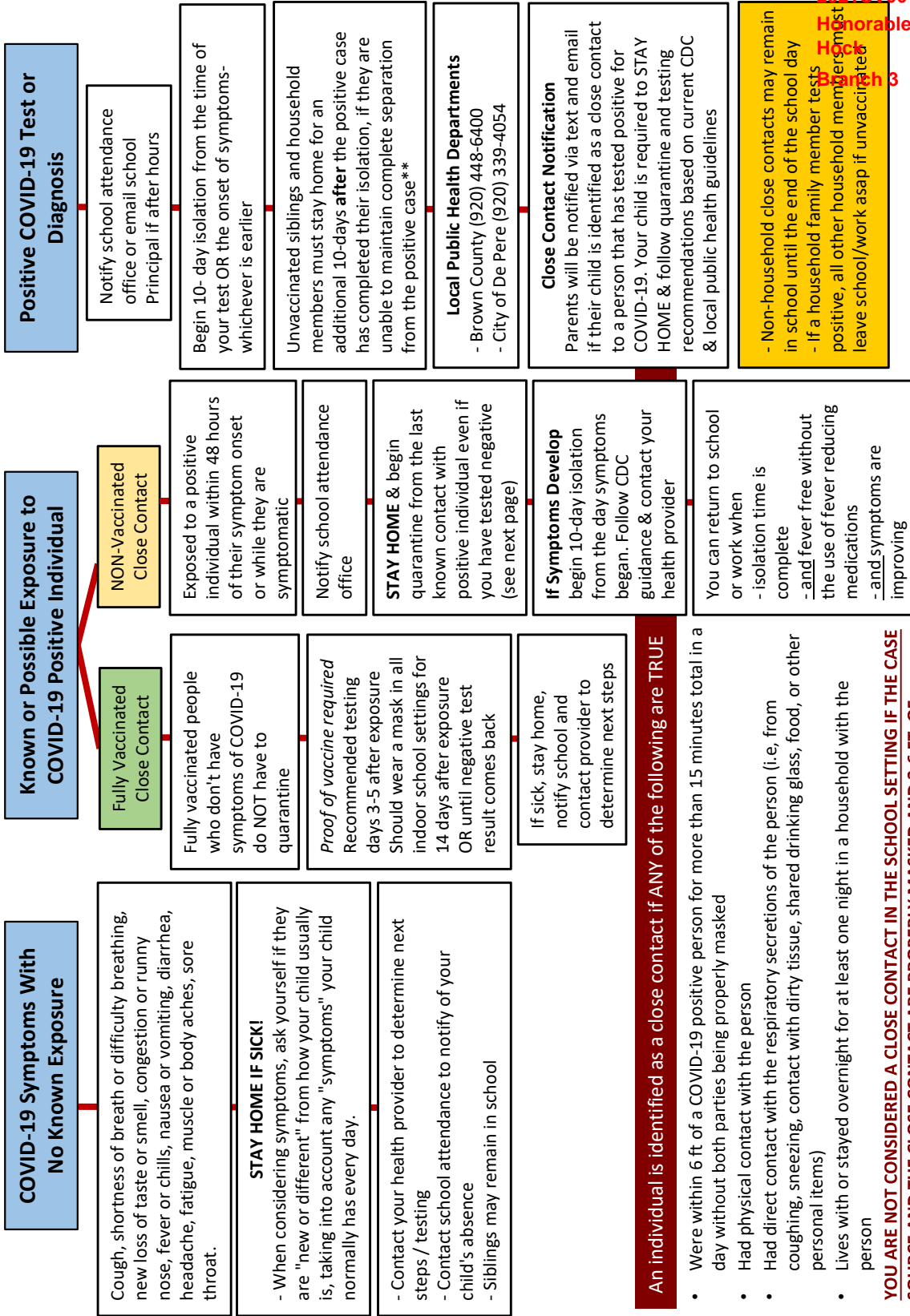

# USDD COVID-19 Exposure Protocols



**An individual is identified as a close contact if ANY of the following are TRUE**

- Were within 6 ft of a COVID-19 positive person for more than 15 minutes total in a day without both parties being properly masked
- Had physical contact with the person
- Had direct contact with the respiratory secretions of the person (i.e. from coughing, sneezing, contact with dirty tissue, shared drinking glass, food, or other personal items)
- Lives with or stayed overnight for at least one night in a household with the person

**YOU ARE NOT CONSIDERED A CLOSE CONTACT IN THE SCHOOL SETTING IF THE CASE SOURCE AND THE CLOSE CONTACT ARE PROPERLY MASKED AND 3-6 FT. OF DISTANCE IS MAINTAINED**

# USDD Shortened Quarantine

## Exposure Date = Day Zero

### 10 - DAY QUARANTINE

- Can end **after** DAY-10 **without testing** and if **no symptoms** have been reported during daily monitoring
- The 10 days starts after your last contact with a person who has COVID-19
- Watch for fever (100.4), cough, shortness of breath or other COVID symptoms
- If possible stay away from others, especially people who are at high risk
- Continue to monitor for COVID-19 symptoms for 14 days

### 7 - DAY QUARANTINE \*\*

- Can end **after** DAY-7 with a negative PCR test if no symptoms have been reported during daily monitoring
- Exposed individual can get tested no sooner than DAY 6 of their quarantine and should remain in quarantine until a test result comes back
- If test result comes back negative and individual has no symptoms, the last day of quarantine must be through day 7, returning to work/school on day 8.
- Continue to monitor for COVID-19 symptoms for 14 days

- If symptoms develop after the 7 or 10 day quarantine is complete, immediately self-isolate and contact healthcare provider

- Notify school

### Fully Vaccinated Person

- Does NOT have to quarantine if determined to be a close contact**
- This exception applies if the fully vaccinated individual is symptom-free
- People are considered fully vaccinated 2 weeks after their second dose in a 2-dose series, such as the Pfizer or Moderna vaccines, or 2 weeks after a single-dose vaccine, such as Johnson & Johnson's vaccine

### Documented History of COVID-19

- Someone who had COVID-19 illness within the previous 90 DAYS and
- Has recovered and
- Remains without COVID-19 symptoms, does NOT have to quarantine if determined to be close contact.
- Past positive test results are required to be verified.
