On 09/04/2023, Clintonville Police Department was dispatched to the area of the Memorial Street bridge for a possible overdose. When I arrived on scene I observed the male suspect standing over [REDACTED]. The male suspect identified as JORDAN D. PETERS stated that he stabbed her and threw a closed knife at my feet. I took the JORDAN D. PETERS into custody and placed him in the back seat of my squad. The Clintonville Area Ambulance service and officers on scene provided medical aid to [REDACTED] until she was flown to THEDA CARE NEENAH. While providing medical aid to [REDACTED] she stated to me that her son JORDAN stabbed her. [REDACTED] was later pronounced deceased at THEDA CARE NEENAH.

I later read JORDAN D. PETERS his Miranda rights and he agreed to talk to me. JORDAN D. PETERS admitted to stabbing [REDACTED] once in the chest. JORDAN D. PETERS said that he has been planning on killing [REDACTED] for about a week.
