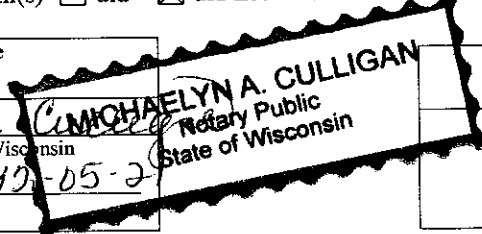

I believe the arrested person committed this offense(s) because: (summarize below)

On Saturday, 07-28-18, Officers and Detectives responded to Holy Family Memorial Medical Center, 2300 Western Ave., for a report of a 3 yoa child (DF) who was brought into the emergency room by his mother for treatment of severe internal and external injuries. CPR was performed by ER staff and DF was transported to St. Vincent Hospital where he underwent emergency surgery. DF was then transported to Children's Hospital of Wisconsin in Milwaukee. DF underwent further surgery and ultimately was pronounced dead at 1738 hrs. on 07-28-18.

Through the course of the investigation, it was determined that Jamie Schrank and her live-in boyfriend, Eduardo Gamez, live at 2009 Waldo Blvd. and would babysit for DF at their residence while his mother was working from about 6:00am - 3:00pm Tuesday through Friday. Jamie and Eduardo have a 5 yoa child in common, EG. Through interviews conducted with Eduardo, he admitted both he and Jamie smoke methamphetamine. He stated that the use was only occasional. Through interviews with Jamie, she admitted that on Thursday, 07-26-18 and on Friday, 07-27-18, she and Eduardo both smoked methamphetamine together from a glass smoking device at about 8:00 am on both Thursday and Friday. During that time, both DF and EG were present both days. Jamie stated the methamphetamine was smoked in a separate room from where the boys were. Jamie said she smokes meth about 3 times per day.

On 07-31-18 a search was conducted at 2009 Waldo Blvd. based on information Jamie had provided about where the methamphetamine pipe was located. The pipe was not found there, however in the drawer she said the pipe would be in we did locate a clear, plastic bag with a white substance inside. The bag was later weighed at 0.3grams and the substance tested positive for methamphetamine. This would have been found in the

bedroom Eduardo and Jamie share. Other clear, plastic bags with residue were located in the bedroom as well. Jamie advised this was how the methamphetamine is packaged when purchased.

On 08-01-18 at 1:13 pm, we went to 809 Jackson St. after receiving information Jamie was there. As we exited our squad to attempt contact with Jamie, she exited the residence and approached us. Jamie was carrying a purse and a larger bag. Jamie was placed under arrest for Neglecting a Child. Jamie stated she was headed to the courthouse for a hearing involving her child. She advised there was a meth pipe and methamphetamine in a sunglasses case in the bag. A search of the sunglasses case found in the larger bag revealed a glass 4" pipe commonly used for smoking methamphetamine which was wrapped in a cloth. Beneath this was a clear, plastic bag that contained a white crystal-like substance. The bag/substance weighed 0.7 grams and the substance tested positive for methamphetamine. When Jamie was taken to MTSO, jail staff located a cellophane wrapper in a pocket of a small zippered pouch that contained a green leafy material. This substance was turned over to Det. Kowalski and I and looked and smelled like marijuana. The material weighed 0.6 grams and tested positive for marijuana/THC.

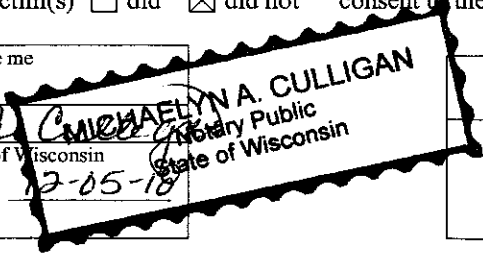
