


Oregon/Jackson Street Bridge City Council Workshop March 22, 2022

Project Background/History

The existing bridge was constructed in 1956 and is nearing the end of its service life. While the bridge is still safe for all travel, a recent investigation of the bridge (April 2021) has confirmed a number of issues that need to be addressed. After suspending the study in 2017, the study has resumed and WisDOT is investigating a wide range of improvement alternatives.

Construction is tentatively scheduled for 2028.
